Absent?

- Assignments given before your absence should be submitted the day you return.
- You have two weeks from the day you return to make up missed assignments. Check the absent folder in the classroom to find your copy of any handouts you missed.
- Work missed due to an unexcused absence cannot be made up.

Passes

- Each student receives **three passes** per term.
- You can use a pass to turn in work late (up to one week), to re-do an assignment, or to use the hall pass (for 10 minutes max).
- You may turn in unused passes at the end of each term for extra credit (2% for all three).
- Passes cannot be replaced if lost.
